Melani has an extensive background in sustainable agriculture and land stewardship. Beginning in 2001, she worked at Wailele Farm (Twin Falls) where she grew plants and trees of many varieties and created "Gardenof-Eden" spaces on the compound. She singlehandedly managed several acres of intensely planted land, including several hundred trees, food and flower gardens, ponds, and wide-open lawns.
