



Dear Friend of Leilani Farm Sanctuary,

We are so happy to welcome Isabella, a tiny orphaned fawn, to Leilani Farm Sanctuary! Just days old, Isabella was found in an abandoned chicken coop. It is likely that her mother was killed by hunters, but we really don't know. Since receiving her at the farm, we have been bottle-feeding her infant formula and keeping her indoors at night.

As a member of the board of Leilani Farm Sanctuary, I am asking if you might be able to help. As the farm grows, we are excited to be able to save more animals like Isabella, but our expenses are growing. We have veterinary expenses, we need to build a second goat barn to make room for the goats to stay dry when it rains, and we have another 1 1/2 acres we can expand into if we can raise the funding to fence it in. We can save a number of new animals from slaughter, abuse and uncertain futures if we can expand into this additional area.

**Can you help us to help the animals?** We are asking you to commit to donating a certain amount every month for the care of baby Isabella and the other animals on the farm. Any amount would be helpful - \$10, \$50, \$100 a month? Knowing that we can expect a certain level of funding each month will allow us to plan for the future, and save more animals. Just a little bit can make a big difference. Just \$10 a month can help us to feed them. **Every little bit makes a difference.** Can you contribute a monthly pledge?
